

Comprehensive healthcare reform law enacted March 2010

 - The patient protection and Affordable Care Act (3/23)
 - Healthcare and Education Reconciliation Act (3/30)

Health Insurance Reform

- Hold Insurance companies more accountable
- Lower healthcare costs
- Guarantee more healthcare choices
- Enhance the quality of care



Affordable Care Act

- Small business tax credit to provide health insurance coverage, 2014
- Represent the largest middle class tax cut in history
- Increase health insurance coverage to the 32 million currently uninsured
- Set up a new competitive private health insurance market



 Improve productivity without substantially increasing cost



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Recruitment of New Physicians


- Maintain attraction

- Turnover can be a facilities largest expense
 Up to 50% of a candidate's annual salary (mgma.com)
- Programs focused on:
 - Retention
 - Continued education
 - Internal promotion



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Increasing Efficiencies

- Conversion to Electronic Health Records
- Electronic Insurance submissions
- Standardization of practice
 - OR preference sheets
 - Intake forms
 - Discharge instructions





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Minimally Invasive Techniques

- Increase in bone biologics
- Less complex surgery
- Greater emphasis on interventional procedures
- More spine procedures being done outpatient



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Educational Advancement

- In the shadow of a nursing shortage The American Nurses Association will look towards specialized training / certification
- For physicians and advanced practice nurses alike education level may soon impact insurance reimbursement
- The Academy of Nurse Executives recently created the first Nurse Manager Certification (AONE, 2010)

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Growth of Outpatient Care

- Ambulatory Surgery Center's grew 38% from 2003-2008
- Bureau of Labor and Statistics predict ASC to outpace hospital growth by 45.4%


